

## **Community Garden Safety Information and Rules**

The success of any accident prevention program depends on constant and active participation of all gardeners, guests, and visitors. If you see a hazard, report it to staff or call Garden City Harvest's main office (406-523-3663).

- In the event of an emergency, CALL 911 immediately.
- All gardens are drug-free areas. No tobacco, alcohol, or other drug use is allowed on or near the premises.
- Respect all gardeners, visitors and staff. Do not use abusive or profane language or discriminate against others. Work to keep the garden a happy, secure, and enjoyable place where all participants can garden and socialize peacefully.
- Exercise caution when working in the gardens. Muddy terrains, uneven ground, tripping hazards (twine, stakes, trellising, rocks etc.) or tools can lead to injury.
- Keep pathways clear and wide enough for a person and a wheelbarrow to get through.
- Protect your feet! All gardeners, volunteers, guests, and employees are recommended to wear closed-toed or work-friendly footwear.
- Always wear proper eye, face, and body protection before operating any machines or power tools. These individuals use the equipment at their own risk.
- Respect all tools and property. Keep tools on site, put tools away, and coil hoses when done. Always lock the shed/gate.
- Garden tools can be dangerous if used carelessly or improperly. Please make sure you understand the proper use of any tool. If you need help or information, please contact a Leadership Committee member or Garden City Harvest staff person.
- Out of respect for communal property and to reduce hazards, dispose of all trash, debris, twine, or broken trellising off site. There is no trash service on site pack it in & pack it out.
- Pets are welcome at the garden unless posted otherwise. If allowed, they must be supervised and on-leash at all times. Pets must be cleaned up after.
- If you see someone working carelessly, speak up and advise them to work safely.
