

Garden City Harvest Job Description PEAS Farm Mobile Market Operator

Hours: Every Tuesday, 12:30 - 7:00pm from June 11 through August 27,

2024 for a total of 78 hours

Wages: \$16/hour. This is a temporary position.

Supervisor: PEAS Farm Director

Garden City Harvest's Mobile Market brings seniors with limited income access to produce and social interaction by setting up a pop-up market stand at four senior living facilities around Missoula. Each week, a team of two will pick up produce from the PEAS Farm, drive to each site, set-up, staff, and tear down each market. We sell the Mobile Market produce at an affordable rate and customers may use special vouchers to access produce.

Duties:

Assist in every aspect of operating a mobile farmer's market: driving to market locations, stand set-up and tear-down, taking money and/or vouchers, engaging with seniors, talking about vegetables

Foster positive relationships while working alongside staff and seniors

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

Passionate about supporting the local food movement and providing seniors access to vegetables

Organized, timely, and dependable

Outgoing, social, and have good customer service skills

Ability to stand for long periods, to lift up to 50 pounds, and to load and unload boxes of produce and other market stand supplies from a truck

Must have a good driving record and a valid Montana driver's license
